**Introduction:** Elihu's first speech in chapter 32 is about God's mission for our mouths. Since God is our Creator, and He created us to speak, our words belong to Him. Words were created *by* Him, exist *through* Him and are to be used *for* Him. Our ability to communicate is to help us do His work and bring Him glory. We are ambassadors of his kingdom, and we must deliver his message. Are we acting like God's ambassadors? The one thing E-lihu teaches us is that an ambassador must deal with conflict. And the only way to do that is through a humble, loving, courageous confrontation. Elihu's speeches were preserved to show us how to be better ambassadors!

**I. As ambassadors, we must speak up** (vs. 1-3)

**II. As ambassadors, wait patiently before speaking** (vs. 4-5)

**III. As ambassadors, apologize for not speaking sooner** (vs. 6-7)

**IV. As ambassadors, quench not the Spirit** (vs. 8-10)

**V. As ambassadors, be sure to gather the facts** (vs. 11-15)

**VI. As ambassadors, speak for the benefit of yourself** (vs. 16-20)

**VII. As ambassadors, fear God & refuse to be impartial** (21-22)
