C. Do you teach people to listen to God in pain? (vs. 19-22)

Tool #4 – Words of Hope (vs. 23-30)

A. Do your words lead people to Christ? (vs. 23-25)

B. Do your words lead people to repentance? (vs. 26-27)

C. Do your words lead to spiritual joy? (vs. 28-30)
