Introduction: Have you ever wondered, “What does it mean to be spiritual?” We tend to think of someone who is spiritual in terms of manmade categories. We think people are spiritual by the things they do and don’t do. Well, there is a grain of truth to that statement. When someone is spiritual there will be outward signs of an inward change. But true spirituality comes from being Christ-like, not by following rules. In Galatians 6:1, the apostle Paul shares with us a blueprint of true spirituality. Those who follow this method can be said to be the truly spiritual. As we study Job 36 this evening we are going to watch a spiritual man in action! As an ambassador of God, Elihu understood His mission for his mouth.

B. God is just, but He still cares (vs. 7)
