

*Elihu's Doxology*  
Job 36:26-37:24

**Introduction:** Tonight we've come to the last speech of E-lihu in the book of Job. The closing argument of his speech is a grand finale of the power of God. In the last 32 verses, there are 33 references to thunder, lightning, clouds and rain. It is quite obvious that the weather is cooking something up in the distance. So, E-lihu adapts a running commentary on these meteorological changes, and he interprets them spiritually to help Job with his suffering. In this doxology, E-lihu will attempt to reconcile his friend with God and prepare him for the coming theophany.
