Nehemiah 1:1-11

Introduction: Every day we wake up, we are part of a Divine agenda known as God's kingdom. If we settle for anything less than that, we are missing our calling in life! Nehemiah faced the same struggle with a calling that we face. He was living in a day when God's people were not heeding God's word. But by God's grace, Nehemiah caught a vision of God's word and was stirred to action to do something. The lessons we can glean from his life are so relevant for our church today. We need to become kingdom minded and take the Gospel to our community. Our text will reveal 5 parts that comprise a kingdom minded person.

I. Kingdom Minded Believers See the Need (vs. 1-3)

II. Kingdom Minded Believers Feel the Need (vs. 4)



III. Kingdom Minded Believers Pray About the Need (5-10)

A. The prayer exalts God, not self (vs. 5)

B. The prayer includes a confession of sin (vs. 6-7)

C. The prayer reviews the truth (vs. 8-10)

IV. Kingdom Minded Believers Share the Need (vs. 11a)

V. Kingdom Minded Believers Volunteer to Meet the Need (vs. 11b)

Conclusion: Nehemiah volunteered and with the help of God, he completed his vision! In 52 days the walls were rebuilt, the gates were restored and the people rejoiced! And it all started because one man was kingdom minded and cared! God is still looking for people who care and are concerned. I pray the Holy Spirit would not leave one of us alone until He does His work in our own hearts about this great need.
