

## *Behold He Comes in the Clouds!*

*Job 38:1-3*

**Introduction:** Job will now get exactly what he'd been asking for—a personal meeting with God. What strikes us immediately is not so much what God says, for it's "all-good!" Rather the most striking part is what God doesn't say. There's no apparent attempt to answer Job's questions regarding his suffering or any hint that Job has been caught in a comic struggle with Satan. Instead, we are taken on a tour of the created order: the heavens and the earth. A careful study of this passage will reveal a gracious mind at work on the soul of a suffering saint. This passage of Scripture is so relevant for us, for we too, like Job, long to meet God and have our problems answered. The good news is that there are principles from these verses that will help us with the problem with problems.

### **I. We Have a God Who Is Always Listening to Us (vs. 1)**
