I. I know There is a Redeemer (vs. 25)

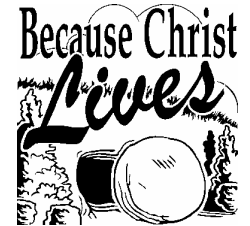
* 4 necessary components for a person to be redeemed:

1. A person must have an urgent need.
2. The victim's redeemer had to be a relative.
3. The kinsman redeemer had to be able to pay the price.
4. The one redeeming had to be willing to redeem.

A. Because He lives (vs. 25a)

B. Because He Will Stand (vs. 25b)
