**Introduction:** Young people I plead with you to capitalize on and make the most of your walk with God! Don't be a careless Christian who lives day by day with no thought of a deeper walk with God. In Psalm 1 we have a plea for a deeper, more solid and more productive walk with God. According to the author the one who has a close walk with God is called blessed. So the question before us is, how can we make the most of our walk with God? If we are going to do this, we must look in three directions because of three specific reasons.

1. Fruitful

2. Durable

3. Prosperous

A. Will you be judged among the ungodly? (vs. 5)

B. Will you be judged among the righteous? (vs. 6)
