Introduction: It seems as though Eliphaz is sincerely calling on Job to repent and seek God. His exhortation is a beautifully handcrafted God-centered appeal to a sinner. Although this sermonette did not apply to Job, it certainly applies to us. For embedded within these final words, is a problem common to all humanity which is: many believers are spiritually anemic because they simply do not get acquainted with God the Father. To become familiar with the Father is not something that comes natural to man. The process must be planned and followed after diligently. Eliphaz's closing speech will reveal to us 6 ways you can get to know God better.

I. By Submitting to God's Way of Reconciliation (vs. 21)
