Introduction: Baptism seems to be somewhat of a non-issue in the church today. At best, among many people baptism has become a secondary issue. Why is it that so many people have little concern for this spiritual matter? Let's face it, there is a lot of confusion out there about what baptism is all about. So what I'd like to do is review what baptism is all about. The way I'd like to do this is by turning to a passage in Romans chapter 6. I believe this text will give us the best picture of what this act symbolizes.

I. Baptism Illustrates the Gospel of Jesus Christ (vs. 1-4)

II. Baptism Depicts Our Union With Jesus Christ (vs. 5-8)

A. Freedom from sin (vs. 5-7)



B. Freedom from death (vs. 8)



III. Baptism Points to the Sufficiency of Christ's Sacrifice (9-10)

A. His resurrection proves He conquered death (vs. 9)

B. His death was sufficient for our sins (vs. 10)



IV. Baptism is a call to Commitment for the Believer (vs. 11-14)

A. Commitment to die to your sin

B. Commitment to live for Jesus Christ
