**Introduction:** Throughout the book Job pours his heart out to the Lord and wrestles with Him in prayer. But of all Job's prayers in the book, this one in chapter 27 is one I can't get over! When his three close friends falsely accused him, what do you think Job did? He prayed fervently for them! Despite all the pain they caused Job, he prayed for them.
