Introduction:

I. The Doubt Of The Israelites – Exodus 14:1-12.

A. Exodus 13:17-22 explains how we get to where we are in Exodus 14.

B. God purposely led His people into this “trap” – Exodus 14:1-4.

C. Note the Israelites initial reaction to their circumstances – verses 10-12.

D. This incident illustrates why it is so important for us to remember what God has done.

E. They looked at their circumstances instead of looking to God.

II. The Deliverance By Faith – Exodus 14:13-22.

- A. There is no record that God told Moses what He was going to do.

- B. Note his remarkable response – verses 13-14.

- C. Moses gives the people 3 imperatives – verses 13-14.

- D. God delivers the Israelites – verses 15-22.

- E. How was this miracle accomplished?

III. The Destruction Of The Egyptians – Exodus 14:23-28.

- A. Pharaoh's army pursue them – verse 23.

- B. God destroyed the Egyptians – verses 25-28.
